Janice,

I will not be able to attend the meeting, these are the questions/comments that we have.

1. Applicant needs to update the Vehicle Turning Plan to verify that fire department access is available in accordance with the State Fire Code (NFPA 1 Chapter 18). It would appear that the latest layout might not provide access around the building.
2. Based on initial review it would appear that 2 fire hydrants are necessary to meet the required fire flow demands as outlined in the State Fire Code (NFPA 1 Chapter 18). We would propose hydrants on opposing corners of the building with one closest to the sprinkler fire department connection.
3. In order to verify the adequacy of the water supply available at the site a hydrant flow test would be required. Applicant should work with a fire protection engineer and/or a sprinkler contractor to determine sprinkler demand requirements.
4. The Fire Department does not have a ladder truck at this time. We rely on mutual aid from Hopkinton or New London typically for a ladder truck. Depending on the type of call, staffing and call volumes a delay may occur from those towns providing Warner this resource if needed. This could have a negative impact depending on the emergency.
