Central topic: The possibility of having a “**Button-Up Workshop**” event in Warner.

- NH towns can host Button Up Workshops. Residents discover opportunities to learn about energy efficiency, how to make smart energy choices, and how to take advantage of available incentives, NHSaves, and others.
- Robbin Adams from the Plymouth Area Renewable Energy Initiative is our contact for planning a Button Up Workshop, and the Warner EC will investigate the details involved with hosting an event.
- The Town of Bradford’s EC is interested in taking part in the “Button-Up” and even offered to host the event in their recently renovated Town Hall. Warner welcomes Bradford’s collaboration, but we prefer to host the event at our Town Hall, which may offer better examples of needed improvement.
- The event would happen during the week and in the evenings (6-7:30 PM or 6:30-8 PM). Events last no longer than 2 hours.
- Dates were considered; The recommended options are either in the Spring or Fall. Bradford wishes to have it in the Spring, and Warner’s EC agrees. Three possible dates were suggested. **4/10, 4/17 and 4/24.**
- Harry offered to check if the dates were workable and report back to the EC with more details.
