Article 01 To fund up grades to Plant

To see if the Warner Village Water District will vote to raise and appropriate up to \$20,000,000 to cover the cost of testing, engineering, and construction of the District's Treatment Plant up-grades and to authorize the issuance of up to \$20,000,000 of bonds or notes in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Finance Act (RSA 33) and to authorize the Commissioners to issue and negotiate such bonds or notes and to determine the rate of interest thereon; further to authorize the Commissioners to apply for, obtain and accept Federal, State, or other aid, grants, gifts or other forms of assistance which may be available for said project. Recommended by Commissioners and the Budget Committee. (3/5 ballot vote required, polls stay open for one hour).

Article 02 To Choose on Commissioner for three years

Article 03 To choose a Clerk, and a Treasurer for one year

Article 04 To Raise and Appropriate I2025 Budget
