

Minutes of the Meeting of the
Warner Village Water District Commissioners
3:30 P.M. on
June 10, 2026 at the Treatment Plant

Present: Dan Lavoie, Shaun Murphy, and Herm Blanchette, Commissioners; Ray Martin, Administrator; Chuck Come, Superintendent; and Jim McLaughlin, Clerk. Also, Dave Prickett, DPC Engineering.

Approval of Meeting Minutes

The minutes of the meeting of the Commissioners on April 22, 2026 were approved as submitted.

Treatment Plant Upgrade

Dave Prickett gave the Commissioners an update on the first phase pilot testing for copper removal being conducted by the Nexom Bluepro company. Emphasis has been placed on identifying the optimal selection of coagulants and dosing. Dave described the work that was completed during the reporting period and said that some time was lost in mid-May due to excessive solids loading in the secondary effluent. However, Chuck Come was able to stabilize the system and allow work to resume. Nexom is expected to continue its work for two weeks, ending on June 22.

AquaAerobics filter system will be brought in at the end of June to test their copper removal technology. Dave said he feels that a two stage system will ultimately be recommended involving coagulants that concentrate the copper in discrete particles and a filtering system to remove these copper particles from the treatment plant's effluent.

May Financial Report

Ray reviewed the revenue and expense reports for May. "We are in good shape", opined Ray.
