BEAUTIFICATION GROUP REPORT AUGUST 2025

SUMMER 2025

We planted annuals in June at the Transfer Station/Highway Department sign, Police Station, Fire Station, Monument, Town Hall and Exit 8 Welcome to Warner sign. Volunteers stepped up to help with watering, weeding and fertilizing through the hot Summer. The sites reflected the selections of each site Captain and, through the season, each was a blaze of glory garnering many compliments. Most plants were purchased at Murray Hill Greenhouses. MadgeTech was a major financial donor along with several private individuals.

During the annuals planting, we amended several of the sites with composted soil from the Transfer Station and enlarged planting areas to have greater impact.

OPEN HOUSE

We are planning a Sunday, Sept. 14 Tour Day of the six sites from 2-3 p.m., rather like an open house with a Captain or volunteer to show off our efforts, explain the process and funding, and serve some light refreshments. There will be a Letter to the Editor in the Intertown Record inviting residents to stop and view the blooms and, perhaps, get involved for the coming Fall plantings.

PELLETIERI CONTRACT

We expect to use our contract with Pelletieri Associates to purchase mums for planting later in September. Mums, pumpkins/gourds, and cornstalks should be in before Festival. Last year we purchased approximately 25 mums, 2 decorative kale, a number of pumpkins and cornstalks. The pumpkins and cornstalks were donated. That may or may not happen this year. This year we will need more mums if we have the new planter and urns in place (they are bigger).

SPRING BULBS

Last year we planted 200 daffodil bulbs through a catalogue, but did not have a good growth rate. This year we would like to purchase the bulbs through the Merrimack Conservation Commission and plant them in mid to late October.

ENCORE GIFT

The gifting of the ENCORE money to the Beautification Group caused us to research many community benefitting opportunities. Our decision to present this proposal is to better light the approach to the Town Hall during evening hours such as for events and Election times. The streetlights don't penetrate to the building and the steps are quite

dark. Coming out of the lighted building, the steps are in darkness. We have viewed this installation as an appropriate and complimentary solution to a potentially unsafe situation making it a good fit for a community wide gift. We have taken great care to have the lights be a safety passage zone, yet not be unnecessary light pollution.

We have invited three electricians to quote on the installation of post lights and building lights at the Town Hall. It was difficult to get three quotes for the scope of work in this area. The third, Rockborn Electric, declined a formal quote, but stated it would be at least \$20,000. He was unsure of being able to provide what we asked. All of the quotes will be for electrical work and installation only as we will purchase the posts, lamps, and lights ourselves. The quotes are good until mid-October when we anticipate receiving the ENCORE donation and each quoting company has stated they are prepared to start construction almost immediately.

The quotes ask for the installation of four (4) 9' posts to be buried in packing material. We chose buried vs. a cement cylinder for cost, ease of "off tilt repair" and esthetics. If the post gets "bumped" by a snow removal process, it will give nearly no damage to the post and requires only to be repacked in the hole. We felt the burying with the pedestal on the ground and no concrete pillar to bolt to would suit the look and age of the building. It is our understanding that the front walkway is shovelled, not plowed with a vehicle, making a possible collision not likely. These will be set in a staggered pattern with a pole on the inside at the beginning of each entrance to the brick walkway and two poles outside the walkway closer to the building. This placement should give a cone of lighting for the walkway from sidewalk to the building steps. Each post will have a decorative base and a 22" lamp with beveled glass enclosing a three-candle bulb receptacle. Post, pedestal and lamps will be in black. The light projected with a soft color. The lamps will be on a timer. Each lamp post will have an electrical outlet for Festival/Farmer's Market use. Connection to electric will be through the ground receptacle by the fence and posts outside the brick walkway will have wiring "punched through underneath" so that the walkway won't be disturbed. We have included Steven Bridgewater in these discussions and he has noted that moving any sprinkler heads is an easy thing and will do so if needed. Pictures of the posts, base and lamps are included with this report.

The building will have three (3) black gooseneck lamps, one on the keystone brick of each archway. The center keystone has an electrical receptacle in place and this mounting site will be used. These lamps will provide light for the steps and the front of the building picking up from the two closest post lamps. Pictures are included with this report.

The ceilings of the two side entryways will have a black lamp. One ceiling is wired, the other needs to be wired. The gooseneck and ceiling lamps will be operated by a switch

in the inside hallway. These lights and lamps will be connected to the electrical panel in the Town Hall basement. Pictures are included with this report.

The center inside arch ceiling already has a hanging black colonial style pendant. This will stay and be connected with the side arch ceiling lights to an inside hall switch.

We checked with a number of lighting companies and through cost and company's information focused on American Gas Lamp Works in New Kensington, PA for the posts, pedestals and lamps. The fixtures are residential, not commercial, making a big difference in price, without sacrificing quality. They are electric, not gas powered.

^{*}Irish Electric has done electrical work on the Town Hall in the past and is familiar with the building's wiring.

^{**}They quoted on buying the electrical equipment and installing the old globe on The center arch, but didn't break that down in the quote. It would be less.

We would like to have Irish do the work as they had the most interest in guiding us in the process and have worked in the Town Hall previously. Should that happen, the total would be \$15,772.04 leaving \$4,227.96 for the shipping and handling costs and any extras that may come up.

PRUNING

The crabapple tree by the driveway between Café One East on the Town Hall has grown out of proportion to the space. It needs pruning for the placement of a lamp post there. We would offer to do a light pruning (no pun intended) of a couple of branches and some vertical suckers to get the post installed, but next year when the trimmers come back to complete the pin oaks trimming, the crabapple needs to be pruned severely on top to prevent limbs breaking.

URNS AND PLANTER BOX

The Group is also homing in on replacing the two pediment urns by the stairs and place a long planter on the top step. We hope to have firm numbers soon. These purchases would come from the Beautification Fund (and include any dollars left from the ENCORE donation).

EXIT 8 SIGN REHAB

The Exit 8 Sign was removed to Jim McLaughlin's workshop. The supporting posts needed to be cut to remove the sign due to extreme age of the sign. The sign was very deteriorated. Jim is looking to rehab this sign by cleaning and repainting the front, replacing the back plywood support and placing a metal frame around the sign to protect it from further deterioration. The process will be a few months. The original quote to rebuild the Exit 9 sign was approx. \$1,200 and was voted by the Select Board last fall to come from the Beautification Fund in the Town Budget. The rehab will probably hit this figure. Three new posts need to be installed at the Exit 8 site and the old sawn-off posts removed. It would be wonderful if those posts could be granite, like the Exit 9 sign has, but wooden posts would be good, too. The building of the Exit 9 sign replacement will wait until the summer of 2026.






